Q3 What skills and/or interests do you have that could help accomplish the GBD mission?

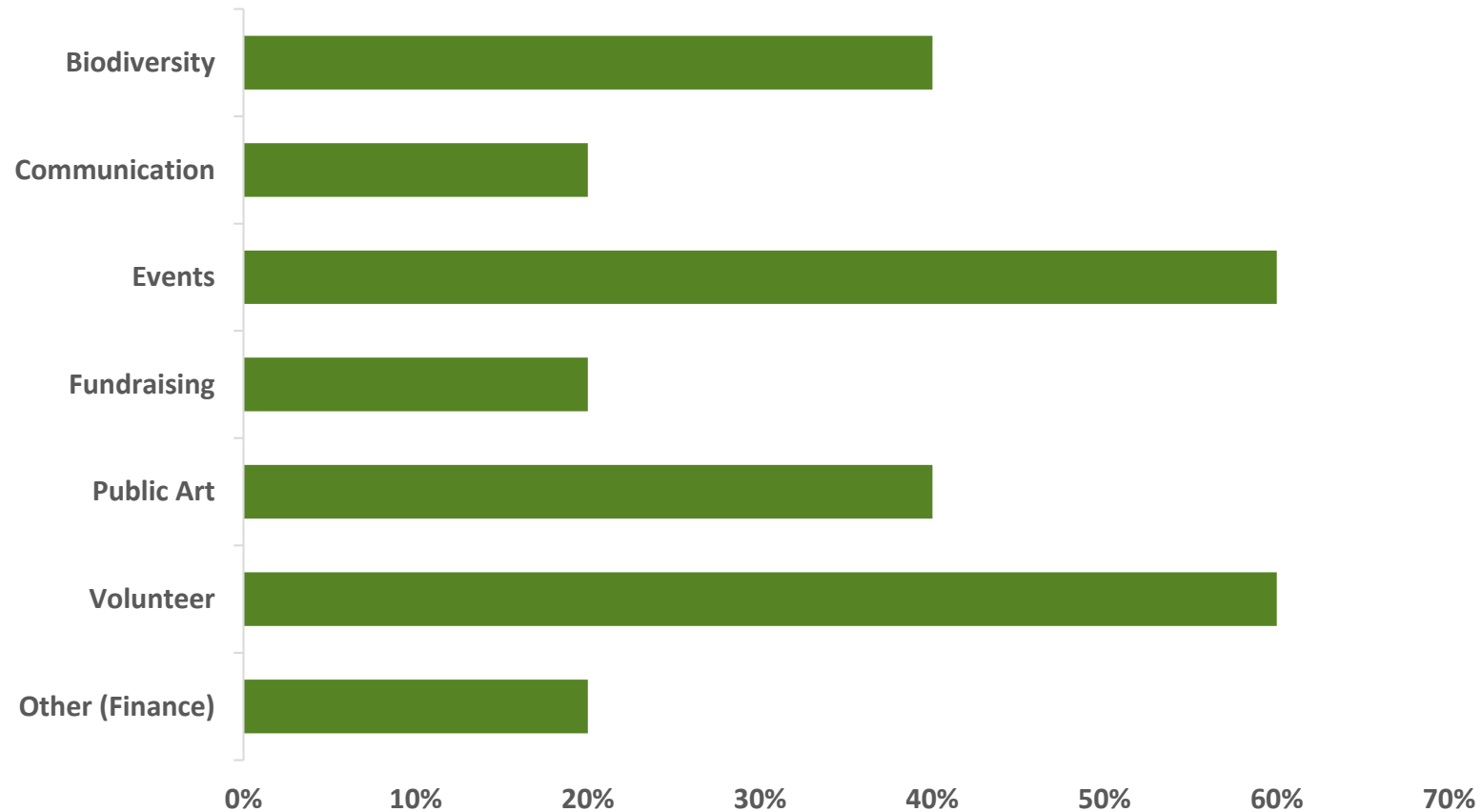
- Project management, event management and art consultation.
