I believe all weather Picnic Tables placed inside the 2 sets of concrete pillars, affectionately known by some as "Dogpatch Stonehedge", would offer an alternative to the tables and chairs already in place. Picnic Tables are colorful seating where small groups can meet, rest, eat lunch and converse. Evening lighting in the trees in Woods Yard would greatly enhance the area when the Sun goes down. 22nd Street sees lots of foot traffic at night because of the Restaurants and those walking their Dogs. Lighting in the trees would give the Park a welcoming protective feeling in the evening. Lights can be powered by Solar Panels and Battery packs on timers. Somewhat more ambitious is an Industrial Roof over the aforementioned "Dogpatch Stonehedge". Steel beams for supports and corrugated tin roofing would give the Pillars purpose and fit the Industrial character of Dogpatch. A tent like structure would give the seating some protection from harsh weather and rain.
